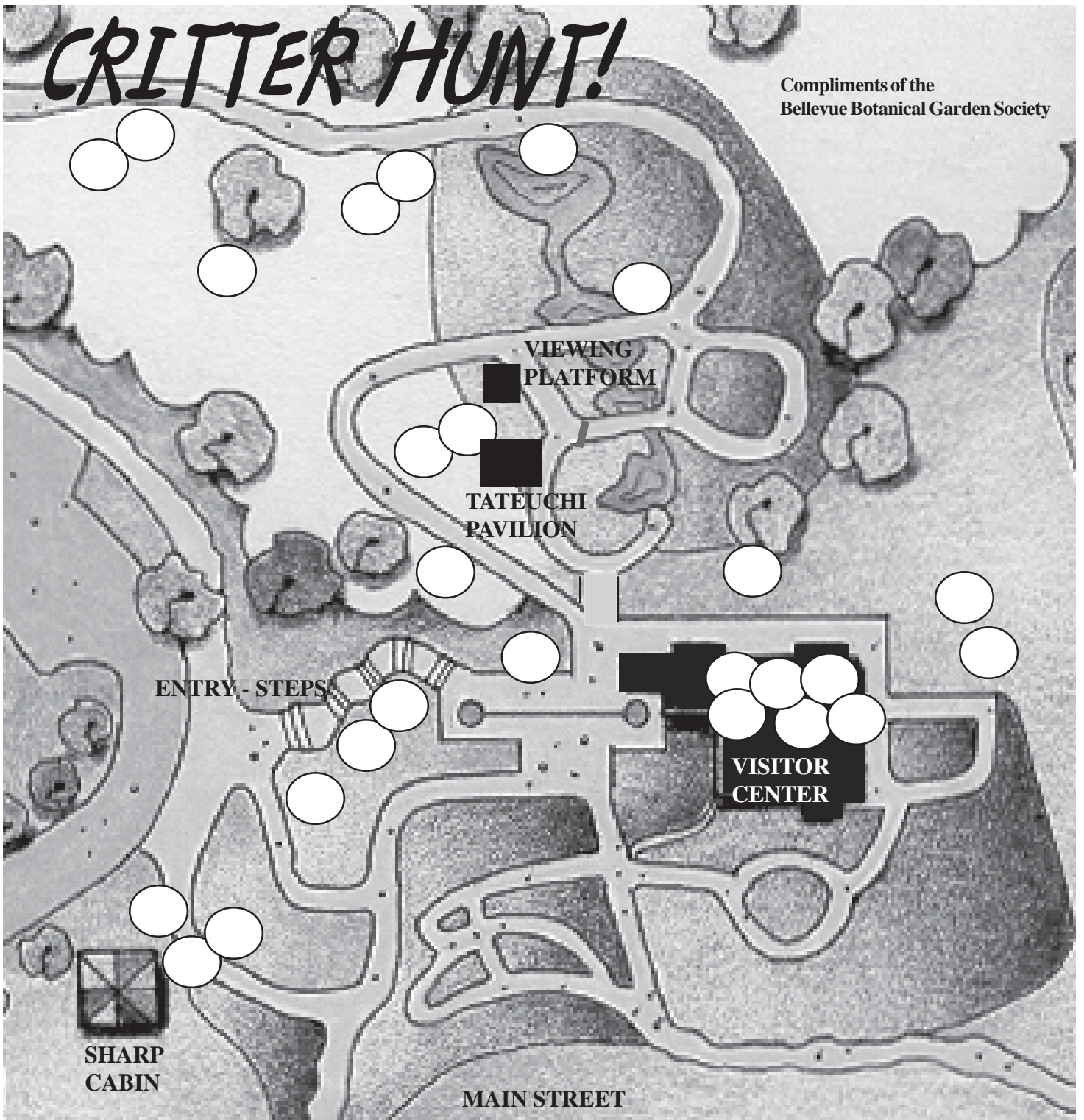


# CRITTER HUNT!

Welcome to Garden d'Lights – a most unique display of flowers in lights. The flowers, trees, and critters in our display were all created and designed here at the Bellevue Botanical Garden by our fantastic group of dedicated volunteers. It takes the average volunteer about one hour per 50 light string to make the flowers. Some of our creations used 5-6 strings of lights, so that means 5-6 hours of work for that particular item.

It costs about \$60,000 to produce this event. Increased costs are due primarily to traffic control, increased security, and more expensive lights. Although about 20% of our costs are met between Bellevue Parks and Community Services, Home Street Bank, and income from parking, light sales and class fees, the remaining balance comes from your donations.

Suggested donations to our display are \$1 per person or \$5 per family. This year when you donate, you can choose to get tickets to enter our drawings for real Garden d'Lights flowers! A \$1 donation enters you into our Nightly Drawing for a primrose pot. A \$5 donation enters you into the Weekly Drawing for a brilliant 8" pot displaying 5 strings of lights made into primroses and hyacinths. A \$10 donation enters you into the Grand Prize Drawing featuring a 12" pot filled with 11 strings of lights made into daisies, primroses, and bluebells. There will be two Grand Prize drawings – one on Dec. 16 and the other on Jan. 2. Be sure to check out the display in our new Welcome Booth at the entrance, or on the table in the Visitors Center.

The dots on this map give approximate locations of our “critters”. We hope you enjoy finding all of them hidden among our flower lights. A master map is located in the Visitors Center in case you need help!

This is the 16th year for our display, which gets bigger and better each year. There are over 1/2 million lights for you to enjoy, including 12,250 new wide angle LEDs on our new Poinsettia Tree.

Approximately 7000 volunteer hours go into our light display, which is a year-round project for us. Be sure to check out the reader board in the Visitors Center for more information and facts about Garden d'Lights.
